Membership Information

The Australian and New Zealand Society of Respiratory Science Ltd. (ANZSRS) is an international body with branches in New Zealand and Australia.

Objectives of the Society

- To provide a forum for scientific and technical communication between members of the profession.
- To advance the knowledge of respiratory physiology.
- To promote excellence in respiratory measurement.
- To encourage training and education in respiratory science.
- To facilitate dialogue with other professional societies with common interests.

Membership Categories

Ordinary Members

Individuals employed in the field of respiratory science who have an appropriate tertiary qualification plus 1 year of relevant experience.

Associate Members

Individuals employed or studying in the field of respiratory science who do not qualify for ordinary membership.

Life Members

Life membership can be awarded by the Board in recognition of outstanding contributions to the Society over an extended period of membership.

Honorary Members

Honorary membership may be bestowed on persons who have made an outstanding contribution to respiratory science or to the society.

Corporate Members

Those companies or businesses or their representatives who have shown interest in the Society and who wish to support the aims

and objectives of the Society, and who are approved by the ANZSRS Board of Directors.

Activities

- The major activities of the society are:
- Annual Scientific Meeting held in association with the TSANZ meeting.
- Regional meetings organised by Regional Representatives.
- Publication of www.anzsrs.org.au
- Running of a Certification Program – CRFS.
- Running of Professional Development workshops.

Application to Join

Application should be made on the prescribed form available from the ANZSRS webpage. The application process requires proposal by a current financial Ordinary member of the Society. If the applicant does not have a proposer, then a member of the Board can act as a referee. The proposal, along with supporting documentation should be forwarded to FCC Secretariat. In case of difficulty the Secretary may be contacted directly for assistance.

Membership Fees

Fees are due on approval of membership and then in January of every year, and are payable in Australian dollars. Financial TSANZ members are eligible for a 25% reduction on ANZSRS fees. ANZSRS has adopted a fee structure offering discounts based on World Bank categorisation of average annual income. The Secretariat may be contacted directly for assistance in this area. Current fees in Australian Dollars (as of 1/01/2013) are:

- Associate Member: 98.18 plus GST
- Retired Member: 30.68 plus GST
