

ANZSRS 2003ASM Evaluation Report

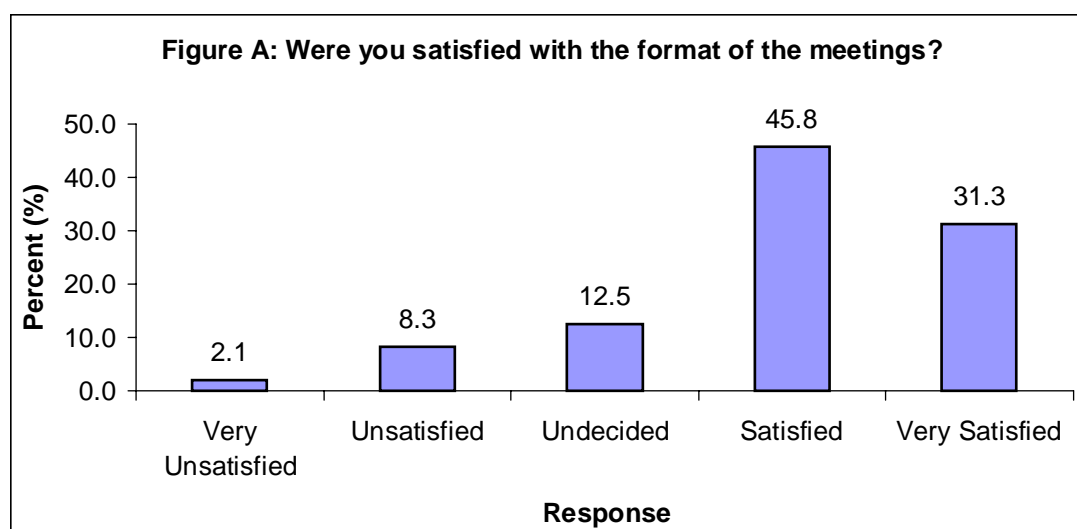
130 delegates attended the ANZSRS 2003 Adelaide ASM. Conference evaluation forms were included in the registration package and the Evaluation was posted on the ANZSRS web site. A total of 50 completed evaluation forms were received, 26 were hand written and 24 were returned electronically. One respondent did not attend the Adelaide ASM. Comments and Suggestions

There were a large variety of comments and suggestions submitted to all questions. Several common themes have emerged as outlined below.

1. The Poster session:

Although respondents didn't want to revert back to having concurrent Poster sessions it was felt:

- There was not enough time for each Poster
- The venue was too big
- There was inadequate discussion/questions of posters
- A formal format is required.

2. Format of the meeting

A number of respondents felt:

- There was an 'information overload' at Symposiums
- There could be a mixture of Symposium and Society presentations on the same day
- The meeting should be extended

3. Farewell Drinks

Although respondents felt this was a good idea, the difficulty in accommodating individuals that need to leave to catch flights home was identified. Several respondents thought that it would be good to have afternoon tea provided, but were unaware that the Sunday afternoon tea is included in the registration.

Other selected comments of interest include:

- Latter start for Sunday
- Include an Advanced trainee teaching session on a specific topic for Respiratory Science at a specialist level
- Would love an annual dinner that included dancing
- The inclusion of an Accreditation progress report – may lead to a more consistent format throughout all labs
- These meetings get better and better
- Great to see so many companies with lung function testing equipment at the Trade Exhibition

The 2003 LOC have survived the experience of organising one of the largest ANZSRS ASM's held thus far. Many thanks, to the members of the 2003 Local Organising Committee for all their hard work.
